Paxton House has one of the last remaining netting stations on the Tweed, and still uses the traditional way of netting using a coble or small boat. The salmon are tagged and released back into the river.

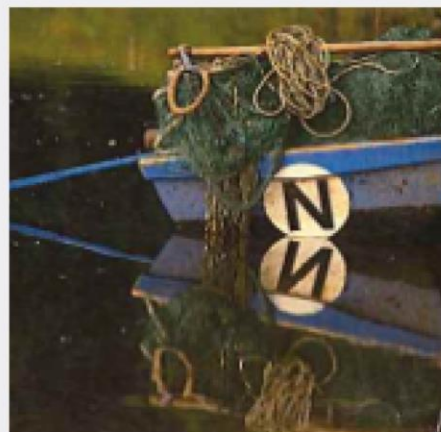
